

INSTRUCTIONS for 2009 KCC/EOA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Please complete all three Pages of the Application with Black Ink – whether hand-written or typed. Please use Black Ink only.

It is important that all pages are 8-1/2” x 11” and ***not*** fastened in a folder or booklet as each application is copied and mailed to the members of the Scholarship Committee for evaluation and the final decision.

Pertaining to the letters of reference, please note – when the application is mailed without the letters of reference included in the packet – some notice should be included that the letters of reference will be coming at a later date.

All Applications are due by Friday, April 3, 2009. If you drop your application off in the Office of your local County Clerk or Election Official by that date and then it is forwarded on to the Chair, this will be within the deadline.
